The McNutt Residential Programs & Services Office has received a report from Craig Solomon, Resident Assistant, and the Indiana University Police Department concerning your alleged involvement in actions which are against University regulations as indicated in the Code of Student Rights, Responsibilities, and Conduct and/or Apt./Residence Halls Rules and Regulations.

Based on the above report(s) and acting as the designee of the Dean of Students, I am charging you with violating Part II, Section H, 22a(1) of the Code which indicate "unauthorized possession, use, or supplying alcoholic beverages to others contrary to law or university policy: (a) Indiana University prohibits: [1] public intoxication, use, or possession of alcoholic beverages on university property (including any undergraduate residence supervised by the university, including fraternity and sorority houses) except as otherwise noted in Part II, Section H, 22(b) and Part II, Section H, 22(c)" is against University policy. Additionally, it is a violation of Apt/Hall Rules A-4 and E-2 of the Rules and Regulations which indicate "residents are responsible for the behavior of their guests while guests are on residence hall grounds" and "residents or guests who are present in a residence hall room and know that a violation(s) is/are occurring will be deemed complicit in the activity unless the person has immediately reported the situation to a university official and/or has left the room upon discovering the violation". Specifically, it is being charged that on April 21, 2006 at 11:30 p.m. in McNutt-Crone B44, you hosted guests who were in a residence hall room where they were drinking and/or in possession of alcohol.

Please call Sandy Moore at 855-1183 to schedule a judicial conference on the above charge(s) by no later than June 16, 2006. At the conference, a decision about responsibility may be determined and if appropriate, a sanction(s) may be imposed. If you fail to appear for the conference, a decision about your case may be made in your absence or you may be placed on the University checklist, which will restrict you from receiving services via the Registrar's office. If you are placed on the University checklist, removal from the checklist may take up to 24 hours.

A copy of the report(s) mentioned above will be available for you to read at the judicial conference or may be reviewed prior to your conference by contacting the Office of Student Ethics and Anti-Harassment Programs at 855-5419 to arrange a time to do so. Any individual mentioned in the report(s) may be called as a witness. Please allow a 24 hour notice to this office to prepare your file for review.
