Dear ██████████:

I write to notify you of the Sexual Assault and Misconduct Board's determination following the hearing held on February 1-2, 2008 regarding the complaint filed against you by ██████████ pertaining to events that occurred in her residence in East Hall the night of the Baxter House Christmas party in December 2005.

The Sexual Assault and Misconduct Board found you responsible for the charge of Sexual Assault as defined by the Bowdoin College Student Sexual Assault and Misconduct Policy as to an act of oral sex and imposed a several part sanction:

1. You will be removed from campus for all non-academic pursuits and will vacate campus housing effective on 5PM, February 18th. You will not be allowed to participate in college-sponsored activities prior to the Baccalaureate ceremony on Friday, May 23rd, 2008. You will be allowed to attend classes, make appointments to see faculty, utilize campus library (and counseling) services, and participate in Commencement activities on May 23rd and 24th, 2008. Any other requests to be on campus must first be approved by me.
2. You will be suspended for the 2008 fall semester. Assuming you complete the requirements for your degree this semester, you will be eligible to seek readmission for the purpose of graduation in December 2008. If you are readmitted at that time and have completed the degree requirements, you may request a letter from the Registrar indicating that you have completed the requirements for the degree, and it will be provided to you. Your diploma will then be mailed to you after the 2009 Commencement ceremony. (Note: the College only confers diplomas once a year at Commencement.)

The process by which you will apply to be readmitted is as follows: for Spring 2009 readmission, you should plan to provide a letter requesting to be readmitted to the Readmission Committee by December 1, 2008. Your letter requesting readmission should describe your experiences while away from Bowdoin and your reflections on this matter. Assuming you request readmission and provide a thoughtful letter, your readmission will be assured.

3. You should continue to have no direct or indirect contact with [REDACTED] for the remainder of your time on campus. You also will be restricted from the Bowdoin campus following Commencement 2008 through Commencement 2009.
4. You will meet with Mr. Geno Ring, a Licensed Substance Abuse Counselor, for a three session evaluation prior to Spring Break. Mr. Ring will provide Counseling with feedback at the end of the evaluation. To set-up this referral, you must meet with a member of the Counseling Service staff, and you can arrange this appointment by simply contacting the Counseling Service at 725-3145. Once you have completed your evaluation, please notify me directly.
