Dear Ms. Morin:

Pursuant to the Clery Act Regulations, 668.46(b)(11), "where the student conduct review process is invoked for a sex offense, both the victim/survivor and the accused must be informed of the final outcome of the student conduct review process without a commitment to protect the confidentiality of the information." The "final outcome" means only the final determination with respect to the alleged sex offense and any sanction that is imposed against the accused.

At the panel hearing held at 11am on January 18, 2005, Mr. Rudolph Taylor was found *not in violation* for **Sexual Abuse and Commission of a Felony or Misdemeanor (#6 and 18 of the "Rules of Conduct" in the 2004-2005 edition of The Golden Rule**).

This means that he will not have to declare that he was found *In Violation* of university policy based solely on this incident. However, he will still have to disclose any violations of university policy that occurred prior or subsequent to this incident.
